• Andrew Arvay called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. The Minutes from October 5, 2022 were distributed and read. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Steven Jennings and seconded by Thomas Hunter. The motion passed.

- Mr. Arvay informed the Council of the existing Council vacancies under the Health Professional Representative group and one under the General Consumer group.
- Mr. Arvay presented Collin Graham as a candidate to fill the General Council Vacancies. A motion to approval Collin Graham was made by Thomas Hunter and seconded by Eric Bartlett. Mr. Arvay requested those in favor of accepting Collin Graham to say "aye" and the motion passed by acclamation This motion will be presented to the Board of Health for Final Approval at an upcoming Board Meeting.
- Ms. Hilton presented the Food Protection Services (FPS) Program updates:
 - o Food Protection Service Program Inspection Summary:
 - As of February 2, 2023, THD-FPS has 4,909 establishments in our inventory.
 - ➤ Between October 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023
 - > 104 permanent closures
 - ➤ 140 newly opened establishments
 - ➤ 45 reopened establishments
 - o Total # plans received since October 1, 2022 = 124
 - Electronic submissions = 80
 - Paper submissions = 44
 - o Total number of COMPLAINTS October 1, 2022 = 35
 - General Complaints = 190
 - FBI = 45
